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#### Duties:

The DCR system includes over 450,000 acres of parks, forests, water supply protection lands, beaches, lakes, ponds, playgrounds, swimming pools, skating rinks, trails and parkways.

The Department of Conservation and Recreation seeks qualified applicants for the position of seasonal Recreation Facilities Repairer.

**DUTIES:**

Inspects recreation facilities to determine the need for repair work and either recommends or performs minor electrical, heating, plumbing and/or equipment repairs to insure safety and maximum operating efficiency of such systems and equipment.

Reviews blueprints, plans, schematics and/or technical manuals for maintenance purposes.

Operates hand power tools, pumps and generators, filter plants and associated equipment in connection with repair work.

Picks up supplies needed for maintenance and repair work.

Performs related duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

**Minimum Entrance Requirements:**

Applicants must have at least (A) one year of full-time, or equivalent part-time, experience in the maintenance, repair and/or installation of heating, electrical and/or plumbing systems or in the maintenance and/or repair of swimming pool or ice skating rink equipment, or (B) any equivalent combination of the required experience and the substitutions below.

I. A certificate issued by a recognized technical institute indicating proficiency in a related trade or craft may be substituted for the required experience.
